California Resolution No. 13

Passed

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article III of our Department By-Laws. From time to time it is necessary to adjust District boundaries in the best interest of the Department. This resolution is to simplify the language of District No. 18.

California Resolution No. 14

Passed

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article III, Committees of our Department By-Laws. From time to time it is necessary to adjust by-laws within the Department. This resolution is to revise the duties and makeup of the Redistricting Committee.

California Resolution No. 15

Passed

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article III of our Department By-Laws. From time to time it is necessary to adjust by-laws within the Department. This resolution is to remove duplications of the National By-Laws.

California Resolution No. 16

Rejected

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article III of our Department By-Laws. Every District Commander shall act as liaison between Posts in the District and the Department and do whatever may be for the best interests of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States. This resolution is to define the duties of the District Commander and District Inspector.

California Resolution No. 17

Rejected

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article VII, Department Conventions of our Department By-Laws. The costs of our Department Conventions are escalating, and the Department currently collects approximately \$20,000 in delegate dues yet the Department Convention costs average of \$45,000 to \$50,000. This resolution is to increase the delegate dues for our Department Convention.

California Resolution No. 18

Pass

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article VIII; Committees of our Department By-Laws. It is essential that the Council of Administration and Audit and Finance Committee (Board of Trustees) be involved in the financial affairs of the Department to provide oversight and independent review functions. This resolution is to establish a policy for the Board of Trustees to review the tentative budget.

California Resolution No. 19

Pass

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article V of our Department By-Laws . It is essential to prepare and adopt a tentative budget for the financial operations of the Department. Part of the duties of the State Quartermaster under the National

By-Laws is to prepare a tentative budget. This resolution is to establish a deadline and process for preparing the Department's budget.

California Resolution No. 20

Pass

The intent of this resolution was to amend Article IV, Per Capita Tax of our Department By-Laws. It has become the practice of the Department to subsidize the per-capita tax of membership dues to reach goals and expectations in membership contests. This resolution is to restrict the use of Department funds in subsidizing membership per-capita tax.

California Resolution No. 21

Tabled

The intent of this resolution was to have a Veterans Remembered Flag that is a symbol of recognition for a group or an ideal and Veterans compose of a group. This Flag would memorialized honor all past, present and future veterans and provide an enduring symbol to support tomorrow's veterans today. The resolution is to instruct the Department Adjutant to send this resolution to National for appropriate action at the National Convention in Orlando, Florida.

California Resolution No. 22

Rejected

The intent of this resolution for VFW National PAC 2008 Candidate Endorsement List is to recommend to the Department Commander and the Department Adjutant that the recommendations of the VFW Political Action Committee be approved as indicated.

California Resolution No. 23

Pass

The intent of this resolution is to actively oppose the proposed amendment to regulations governing admission to the California Veterans Homes that would require an applicant to have a private health insurance plan in effect prior to admission as a resident.

California Resolution No. 24

Pass

The intent of this resolution is to support all legislative efforts to establish an educational benefit program for members of the California National Guard.

California Resolution No. 25

Pass

The intent of this resolution is to support of AB No. 2568 (Houston) or similar legislation.

The intent of this resolution is to have VFW National Quartermaster General designate the software to be used by all Post and Districts.
