PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS FOR DISABLED VETERANS

The Disabled Veterans' Exemption provides relief from property tax obligations for eligible veterans on their primary residence when the Veteran has been rated at 100% due to a service-related disability or due to being compensated at the same rate for unemployability.

This benefit extends to the unmarried surviving spouse of a qualified veteran.





EXEMPTION PROCESS OVERVIEW

Depending on the county where the veteran's property is located, once the appropriate documents are filed, the veteran or surviving spouse of the qualified veteran will receive a revised property tax bill.



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FINANCIAL IMPACT OF THE EXEMPTION

This revised property tax bill typically results in a change in the monthly payment should the veteran or surviving spouse of the qualified veteran have a home loan with an impound account for their taxes.
